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Hand Eczema and Detergents

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Abstract

A questionnaire-type survey was used to study the relationship between hand eczema and detergents. The main purpose of this study was to investigate the differences in types of detergents used as well as the frequency of scullery work and washing between hand eczema patients and control subjects. The following results were obtained:

- 1) Occurrence of eruptions was not related to detergent type.
- 2) Occurrence of hand eczema was related to frequency of scullery work and washing.
- 3) A possible relationship was noted between hand skin types and occurrence of hand eczema.
- 4) Factors such as water source and use of rubber gloves were not related to occurrence of hand eczema.
